

#### Cyber Risk Impacts All Loss Quadrants






## Scope of Traditional Cyber Insurance Coverage

Defense Costs + Damages + Regulator Fines	Insured's Loss	Expenses Paid to Vendors
<ul> <li>Liability Sections</li> <li>Failure of Network Security</li> <li>Failure to Protect / Wrongful Disclosure of Information, including employee information</li> <li>Privacy or Security related regulator investigation</li> <li>All of the above when committed by an outsourcer</li> <li>Wrongful Collection of Information (some policies)</li> <li>Media content infringement / defamatory content</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>First Party Sections</li> <li>Network-related Business Interruption</li> <li>Extra Expense</li> <li>System Failure Business Interruption (some policies)</li> <li>Dependent Business Interruption (some policies)</li> <li>Data Restoration</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Expense / Service Sections</li> <li>Crisis Management</li> <li>Breach-related Legal Advice</li> <li>Call Center</li> <li>Credit Monitoring, Identity Monitoring, ID Theft Insurance</li> <li>Cyber Extortion Payments</li> </ul>



## "Silent Cyber": Potential Coverage Under Traditional Policies
