Marco Frigessi di Rattalma, born in Milan (Italy) in 1960, is since 2000 full professor at the Faculty of Laws of the University of Brescia where he teaches international and private international law. Mr. Frigessi is head of the course in European Union law at the School for forensic professions of the same University. He has also taught at the Universities of Trieste, Trent and Sassari.

He started his legal profession at the law firm Avv. Prof. Mario Casella e Associati and thereafter continuously practised as a lawyer in Milan where since 2003 he acted as of counsel to Pedersoli Lombardi e Associati.

Since February 2012 he acts as of counsel to Simmons & Simmons LLP (Milan Office). The main focus of his practice is European law and private international law with an emphasis on international contractual, corporate and insolvency matters. He also practises in international banking, insurance and financial services and is an expert of litigation and arbitration in an international context.

Prof. Frigessi is the author of three books and about forty articles on topics of European Union law, private international law, insurance and financial law. He is also the editor of several volumes on the same topics. Mr Frigessi regularly lectures and speaks at academic and professional conferences and is on the board of academic journals.
